Parmesan-Ranch **Baked Zucchini Coins**

Prep Time 5 min
Cook Time 10 min
Servings 6

Ingredients (3)

- ¼ cup Parmesan Cheese Grated
- 2 cups Zucchini Washed Unpeeled
- Ranch Dressing ⅓ cup



1. Preheat oven to 475°F.
2. Cut zucchini horizontally into 1-inch slices and spread with ranch dressing (both sides).
3. Lay on cookie sheet and sprinkle with Parmesan cheese.
4. Bake for 10 minutes or until tops are lightly browned.
