HEALTHY APPLE NACHOS (5-MINUTE)

Ingredients

2 apples of choice

1/4 – 1/3 cup natural nut butter (peanut, almond, sunflower, etc.) small handful chocolate chips (I used Enjoy Life Mini Chips) small handful shredded coconut

small handful slivered almonds, optional sprinkle of cinnamon

1 tablespoon lemon juice

Instructions

Apples: Wash, core and cut apples into 1/4 inch slices. Lay apple quarters on a flat surface with the inside of the apple facing up, carefully slice apple into 1/or 1/2 inch slices Place apple slices in a small bowl with the lemon juice, toss to coat. Nut butter: Heat your nut butter just until warmed and somewhat runny. Alternatively, warm in the microwave for 20 – 30 seconds.

Assemble: On a serving plate, lay your apple slices in a single layer around the outside edge, then layer another small layer over those but towards the inside center of the plate (like shown in the picture above). Drizzle the nut butter in a circular motion, from the middle of the plate to the outside edge.
